

YOUR PRIORITIES ARE MY PRIORITIES



- 1 ACCEPTABLE SOLUTION TO STREET PARKING ISSUES:**
The popularity of Dorridge Station has increased street parking and resulted in the creation of Restricted 'Zones' for the worst affected areas, but other roads are now under pressure. I will continue to press for further measures to reduce the impact on local residents.
- 2 LOCAL ENVIRONMENT:**
Fortunate to be surrounded by countryside and with attractive public open spaces, we have low levels of vandalism but others do not always respect our values. I always follow up reports of fly-tipping, graffiti and damage, as well as supporting local clean-ups to maintain pride in our locality.
- 3 ROAD SAFETY:**
We have a good record and the new 20 mph limit in central Dorridge has reduced traffic speeds but speeding remains an issue on some local roads. I support enforcement measures through Hockley Heath and other problem areas.
- 4 PROTECTING CHILDREN:**
Bullying, grooming and sexual exploitation cause misery for too many children and anguish for families. As trustee of a children's charity and with the Council I will work for greater awareness, better support for victims and stronger measures to combat bullying and exploitation.
- 5 DEVELOPMENT PRESSURES:**
The need for more housing will put pressure on local councils but we must protect the character of established communities, take account of pressure on services and ensure any developments meet genuine needs rather than the interest of developers.
